Dear CASMAN Academy Families & Staff;

We have received notification regarding a CASMAN student has tested positive for COVID-19. This student is following quarantining protocols. We have conducted contact tracing and any individual found to have been in close contact has been contacted and will also be following quarantine guidelines. Additional information about this case, or any future cases, will only be released according to District #10 Health Department standards and will always protect the privacy of our students, staff, and families.

We still need to remain vigilant in monitoring for symptoms. Please remember that student temperatures are to be taken and symptoms monitored from home each school day. Families are responsible for deciding if a student should be attending school based upon at-home monitoring each day. Should your student show symptoms they should be kept home (except to seek medical care), monitored, and considered for testing. Please do not send your student to school with any of the following symptoms:

- Fever 100.4 or above
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- Fatigue
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
