

## Goals for 2021-22 School Year:

### Goal 1: Improve Student Achievement

Monitor and provide specific data to meet Student Achievement: Based on student growth on academic measures.

#### Actions:

1. Report baseline data for grades 7-12 at November board meeting. Include base line data on: NWEA, interim assessment (science & social studies only if available), attendance (previous year will be baseline data), Casman Complete (grades – previous year will be baseline), graduation progress (previous year will be baseline).
2. Provide updates on data at February, April, and June board meetings.
3. Provide updates on what is being done to improve results (strategies implemented).
4. Report once-per school year (Fall time) district wide state testing results. This will include data for 2020-21, and multi-year results with available information. Multi-year reports may not be available as COVID-19 impacted testing in previous years.

### Goal 2: Continue to Increase Academic Growth Rates

Continue to work with teachers and staff members to increase academic growth rates of students in grades 7-12 below proficiency standards for their grade level in reading and in math while, at least, maintaining the growth rates of students at or above the proficiency standards. Work with all subject area teachers to increase student growth rates to meet, or exceed, the set target with the School Improvement Plan.

#### Actions:

1. Use NWEA to track academic growth.
2. Monitor teacher's use of strategies to improve growth.
3. Observe and provide feedback to teachers and staff on the use of instructional strategies.
4. Work together with teachers to analyze the data regarding reading and math scores; set improvement targets for each student (EDP plans).
5. Implement a system of support for interventions and additional instruction for students identified (utilize IXL, and other interventions).
6. Communicate with the board, SIP team, parents, and community on the progress of student achievement.
