Che Guevara

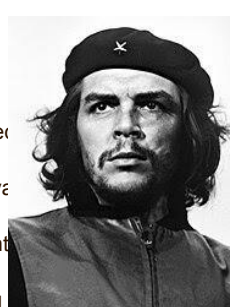
born in Rosario, Argentina June 14 1924 died

Endangered animal of the week: **Amazon River Dolphin**

The Amazon River Dolphin, or Pink River Dolphin, or Boto Rosa, is a critically endangered freshwater species of dolphin found in Bolivia, Brazil, Colombia, Ecuador, Guyana, Peru, and Venezuela. Despite being a cute pink color, or a pink color that can only be described as a "raw baby", it is actually quite large. A full-grown boto can grow up to 9 feet and weigh up to 400lbs.

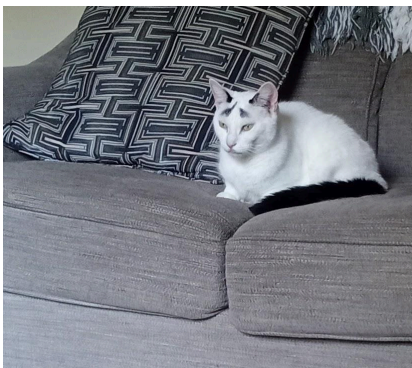
A Short Story in Parts by Max
